Here are the instructions to use the "TOKYO 88" presets for Arturia MicroFreak.

### 1 CONTENT OF THE ARCHIVE

- Readme.pdf: current text file.
- Tokyo\_88.mfprojz: MicroFreak project to transfer with the Arturia MIDI Control Center

### 2 HOW TO USE

#### 2.1 Importing the "TOKYO 88" sounds in your MicroFreak

- MIDI Control Center installation:
  - Download the Arturia MIDI Control Center from this page: <https://www.arturia.com/products/microfreak/resources>
  - Launch the file and follow the different steps to get it installed on your computer
  - Launch the MIDI Control Center
- Transferring the presets:
  - In the product list (top-left corner) select the MicroFreak.
  - Connect your MicroFreak to your computer.
  - In the upper part of the project View, click on the "Import" button then "Import New Project".
  - Select the file Tokyo\_88.mfprojz. This will create a new project named "Tokyo 88" (vertical list on the left).
  - Select the new project "Tokyo 88". This will display the related presets in the list aside the list.
  - You can then transfer those presets in the MicroFreak memory by simple drag-and-drops of an individual preset, or the whole project.
